RESOLUTION 2009-03**

CONSERVATION PLAN REQUIREMENTS ACKNOWLEDGED

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District met in regular, open public session on March 3, 2009, with a quorum present; and,

WHEREAS, the District has implemented a documented Conservation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board and staff realize there is a need for certain assurances to be guaranteed in order to promote support at a state and federal level;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Kennewick Irrigation District's Board of Directors acknowledge any water saved from implementing conservation measures in whole or in part with Federal dollars will result in reduced water diversions from the Yakima River or tributaries thereto in accordance with Title XII of Public Law 103-434, otherwise known as the Yakima River Basin Water Enhancement Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of the Kennewick Irrigation District understands participation in the Yakima River Basin Water Conservation Program requires that all surface water delivery systems within the Kennewick Irrigation District's boundaries must be equipped with volumetric measuring devices or equally effective water measuring methods.

Resolution No. 2009-03 is hereby adopted by the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District, Benton County, Washington, at an open public meeting thereof this 3rd day of March, 2009.
