ACCEPT SURETY, AUTHORIZE FEASIBILITY INVESTIGATION OF THE PROPOSED BRETZ ROAD LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District, Benton County, Washington, for the purpose of acceptance of surety bond and authorization to investigate the formation of **BRETZ ROAD** Local Improvement District (LID), consisting of **Lots 1 and 2 of Short Plat 1240 lying in Section 17, Township 9 North, Range 28 East W.M and All lots of Short Plats 1604, 2210, 2252 and 2271. Lots 1, 2 and 3 of Short Plat 1401 and Lot 3 of Short Plat 2650 lying in section 20 Township 9 North, Range 28 East W.M** shown generally on attached map, Exhibit A.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District met in regular session on April 6th, 2010 with a quorum present, and,
WHEREAS, Exhibit B is a copy of the signed Petition, reciting the nature and general plan of the desired improvement and for the organization of a LID, verified to be the holders of title or evidence of title to one quarter of the acreage proposed to be assessed, attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein has been filed with the Board of Directors (the "Board") of Kennewick Irrigation District, Benton County, Washington (the "District").

WHEREAS, the District has received a one hundred dollar surety and no additional surety is required, conditioned that the petitioners will pay the actual cost of the investigation of the project and the hearing thereon if it is not established. The Board authorizes the feasibility investigation of the proposed BRETZ ROAD LID.



Note: A preliminary study of your area has been conducted and the findings demonstrate sufficient interest to initiate a petition for pressurized irrigation LID. Signing this petition does not commit your property to an LID and LID assessments. Signing simply means that you have an interest in the installation of the specified public improvement and that you will consider paying for the improvements through the formation of an LID. Petitioners are responsible for all costs associated with the preliminary investigation and feasibility study even if the LID is not formed. Once the petition is submitted, the District will prepare and submit to the property owners additional information for the project including cost data and LID procedures before scheduling a public hearing. Actual commitment of your property to the LID will come later through a public hearing process and a decision by the Board of Directors.
