RESOLUTION 2010-19**

WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; AUTHORIZING THE USE OF A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACTOR, HYDROSCREEN, TO MANUFACTURE SIX MECHANICAL WEED SCREENS; AND AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT MANAGER TO PURCHASE THE WEED SCREENS.

WHEREAS, the District has a need to install six mechanical weed screens; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering and Operation Departments determined by a thorough vendor search that Hydroscreen is the only manufacturer in the 17 Western States able to manufacture these six weed screens to meet KID Specifications; and

WHEREAS, Hydroscreen, has submitted a proposal to manufacture, deliver, supply spare parts, and train KID Operations staff in the operation and maintenance of six hydroscreens, a proprietary product; and

WHEREAS, District staff has thoroughly analyzed the proposal submitted by Hydroscreen and has determined the offered price for the six screens is fair and reasonable, and recommended it would be in the District's best interest to accept the proposal; and


WHEREAS, the Engineering and Operations Committee has considered the report of District staff and has concluded that the proposal submitted by Hydroscreen, is fair and reasonable, and determined it would be in the District's best interest to accept.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Kennewick Irrigation District Board of Directors waives competitive bidding; authorizes the use of a sole source contractor, Hydroscreen, for six mechanical weed screens in an amount not to exceed \$24,589.35.

Resolution 2010-19 is hereby adopted by the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District, Benton County, Washington, at an open public meeting thereof this 7th day of September, 2010.




