RESOLUTION 2010-22**

WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; AUTHORIZING THE USE OF A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACTOR, NORSTAR INDUSTRIES, TO OVERHAUL AND MODIFY THE 2001 KID SPRAY TRUCK; AND AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT MANAGER PURCHASE THE LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR THE OVERHAUL AND MODIFICATION.

WHEREAS, the District has a need to overhaul and modify the 2001 KID Spray Truck; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering and Operation Departments determined by a thorough vendor search that Norstar Industries is the only local vendor with demonstrated reliable capabilities to provide the quality labor, equipment, and parts for the 2001 KID Spray Truck overhaul and modification that meets KID Specifications; and

WHEREAS, Norstar Industries, has submitted a proposal to provide labor and parts for the 2001 KID Spray Truck overhaul and modification, with some proprietary products and labor expertise; and

WHEREAS, District staff has thoroughly analyzed the proposal submitted by Norstar Industries and has determined the offered price for the 2001 KID Spray Truck overhaul and modification is fair and reasonable, and recommended it would be in the District's best interest to accept the proposal; and


WHEREAS, the Engineering and Operations Committee has considered the report of District staff, past work completed by Norstar Industries for KID Spray Equipment, and has concluded that the proposal submitted by Norstar Industries, is fair and reasonable, and determined it would be in the District's best interest to accept.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Kennewick Irrigation District Board of Directors waives competitive bidding; authorizes the use of a sole source contractor, Norstar Industries, for the 2001 KID Spray Truck overhaul and modification in an amount not to exceed \$17,905.00.
