**SETTING FEES FOR LORAYNE J  
OPERATIONS AND VARIOUS SERVICES PROVIDED**

WHEREAS, Kennewick Irrigation District (KID) provides various services to its rate payers and community; and

WHEREAS, services to the Lorayne J potable water system benefit individual rate payers in that system exclusively; and

WHEREAS, the cost structure of the Lorayne J system has changed with the need to purchase water from the City of Richland and KID's transfer of the Elliot Lake water system to the City of Kennewick, and


WHEREAS, the District is required by law to charge all of the Lorayne J systems operating and administrative costs to the customers who exclusively receive the benefits of the systems; and


WHEREAS, the District has analyzed the average costs of providing said services and has developed this schedule;


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that, effective July 1, 2017 and superseding fees for services provided to the Lorayne J Potable Water System set forward the in all previous fee resolutions of the Kennewick Irrigation District, fees for services provided to the Lorayne J Potable Water System are established as follows:

Monthly flat rate water fee (billed bimonthly at \$150.63)	approximately	\$75.32/mo.
Potable water delinquency fee		\$20.00
Returned NSF check fee		\$40.00
Potable water shut off fee (for late payment)		\$55.00
New potable water service application fee		\$35.00
Potable water shut off fee (for other than for late payment, such as for repairs)		\$10.00
Irrigation or potable service turn on fee (late payment & paid current)		\$25.00
Potable water meter testing (charge only if meter is functioning normally)		\$100.00
New account fee for new KID customer		\$25.00
Account transfer fee for existing KID customer		\$15.00
