KENNEWICK IRRIGATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION 2020-34

Authorization to Waive Competitive Bidding and Award a Sole Source Contract to Purchase a Used 2012 Genie GTH-1056 Forklift from United Rentals; Pursuant to RCW 87.03.435(3)(c)

A **RESOLUTION** of the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District (KID), Benton County, Washington, relating to the purchase of used equipment; authorizing and directing actions.

Section 1. RECITALS AND FINDINGS.

1.1 The Board of Directors of the Kennewick Irrigation District has established a General Purchasing Policy 2.13 that establishes the rules for acquiring services, contractors, materials, supplies, and equipment.

1.2 RCW 87.03.435(3)(c) provides for establishing the purchase price by direct negotiation if the purchase is clearly limited to a single source of supply or to purchases involving special facilities, services, or market conditions, in which instances the purchase price may be best established by negotiations.

1.3 Pursuant to KID General Purchasing 2.13, Paragraph 6.3.1.5, a sole source purchase may be approved if there is a need for a used item that can be purchased through a distributor, that would represent a good value and is advantageous to KID.

Section 2. FORKLIFT.

2.1 This equipment is required for KID's ongoing maintenance and replacement activities and for improvements included in KID's capital improvement program. These include such activities as canal lining projects, piping projects, and pump replacements and repairs, as well as other maintenance and replacement activities.

2.2 Maintenance and replacement activities and capital improvement projects will continue in the future, and this equipment will be necessary for these ongoing activities.

2.3 During the evaluation process for the purchase of new forklifts, it was brought to our attention that United Rentals has available a used 2012 Genie GTH-1056 10,000 pound variable reach forklift for \$67,000.

2.4 Through an analysis, the cost of ownership per hour of this used forklift is \$8.93, which is a significant cost savings compared to other forklift options, which represent a market condition in which the purchase price is best established by direct negotiation.

2.5 This used 2012 Genie GTH-1056 Forklift represent a unique situation that is of good value and is advantageous to KID.

Section 3. IMPLEMENTATION.

The KID District Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such action as appropriate and necessary to administer and enforce this Resolution.

Section 4. REPEALER; FUTURE ACTIONS.

Any KID act prior to and inconsistent with this Resolution is hereby superseded and repealed. Nothing in this Resolution shall limit the future authority of KID to modify the conditions of this purchase.

RESOLUTION 2020-34 IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District, Benton County, Washington, at a regular open public meeting with a quorum present thereof this 20th day of October, 2020.




