KENNEWICK IRRIGATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION 2021-13

Authorization to Waive Competitive Bidding and Award a Sole Source Contract to Purchase a Used 2006 Finn T400 Hydroseeder with a Used 1998 International 8100 Truck on Consignment through Surplus Equipment Exchange; Pursuant to RCW 87.03.435(3)(c)

A **RESOLUTION** of the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District (KID), Benton County, Washington, relating to a sole source purchase; authorizing and directing actions.

Section 1. RECITALS AND FINDINGS.

1.1 The Board of Directors of the Kennewick Irrigation District has established a General Purchasing Policy 2.13 that establishes the rules for acquiring services, contractors, materials, supplies, and equipment.

1.2 RCW 87.03.435(3)(c) provides for establishing the purchase price by direct negotiation if the purchase is clearly limited to a single source of supply or to purchases involving special facilities, services, or market conditions, in which instances the purchase price may be best established by negotiations.

1.3 Pursuant to KID General Purchasing Procedure 2.13, Paragraph 6.3.1.5, a sole source purchase may be approved if there is a need for a used item that can be purchased through a distributor, that would represent a good value and is advantageous to KID.

1.4 KID has on-going operations and maintenance needs for a hydroseeder.

1.5 KID has a Capital Improvement Program that includes improvement projects that require this equipment.

1.6 Capital improvements will continue in the future, and this equipment will be necessary for these ongoing activities.

1.7 During the evaluation process for the purchase of a new hydroseeder, it was brought to our attention that Surplus Equipment Exchange has, on consignment, a used 2006 Finn T400 Hydroseeder with a used 1998 International 8100 Truck for \$85,000.

1.8 Through an analysis, the cost of ownership per hour of this used equipment is \$9.95, which is a significant cost savings compared to other comparable equipment options, which represents a market condition in which the purchase price is best established by direct negotiation.

1.9 This used equipment represents a unique situation that is of good value and is advantageous to KID.

Section 3. PURCHASE OF USED EQUIPMENT.

3.1 Competitive bidding will be waived and a sole source contract to purchase a used 2006 Finn T400 Hydroseeder with a used 1998 International 8100 Truck on consignment through Surplus Equipment Exchange will be awarded for \$85,000, plus applicable fees, sales tax, and shipping. The payee for the purchase will be based on the payment policies of Surplus Equipment Exchange and licensing requirements.

3.3 Funds for the purchase will come from the Capital Upgrade and Improvement Fund.

Section 3. IMPLEMENTATION. The KID District Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such action as appropriate and necessary to administer and enforce this Resolution.

Section 4. REPEALER; FUTURE ACTIONS. Any KID act prior to and inconsistent with this Resolution is hereby superseded and repealed.
