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AUTHORIZATION TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND AWARD A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT TO PURCHASE A USED IRRIGATION CIRCLE PIVOT SYSTEM PURSUANT TO RCW 87.03.435(3)(c)

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Kennewick Irrigation District has established a General Purchasing Policy 2.13 that establishes the rules for acquiring services, contractors, materials, supplies, and equipment; and

WHEREAS, RCW 87.03.435(3)(c) provides for establishing the purchase price by direct negotiation if the purchase is clearly limited to a single source of supply or to purchases involving special facilities, services, or market conditions, in which instances the purchase price may be best established by negotiation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to KID General Purchasing Procedure 2.13, Paragraph 6.3.1.5, a sole source purchase may be approved if there is a need for a used item that can be purchased through a distributor, that would represent a good value and is advantageous to KID; and

WHEREAS, KID has on-going need to provide irrigation to our leased agricultural farm land; and

WHEREAS, Capital improvements will continue even after KID ends Ag leasing in the future, and this equipment will be necessary for these ongoing activities; and

WHEREAS, during the evaluation process for extending our annual rental agreement, it was brought to our attention that Tony Czebotar has offered KID to purchase the used Irrigation Circle Pivot System already in place for \$60,000; and

WHEREAS, through an analysis using the next five years as an example, the cost of ownership per year of this used equipment is \$12,000, which is a significant cost savings compared to the continued annual rental of \$20,000 for this or other comparable equipment options, which represents a market condition in which the purchase price is best established by direct negotiation; and

WHEREAS, this used 2017 Irrigation Circle Pivot System represents a unique situation that is of good value and is advantageous to KID;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Kennewick Irrigation District Board of Directors waives competitive bidding, and authorizes the purchase of the aforementioned used 2017 Irrigation Circle Pivot System for a total amount of \$60,000 plus applicable sales tax, to be paid from the Realty Reserve Fund.

Resolution 2021-18 is hereby adopted by the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District, Benton County, Washington, at an open public meeting thereof this 1st day of June, 2021.
