KENNEWICK IRRIGATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION 2022-06

ACCEPTANCE OF COTTONWOOD MEADOWS DEDICATION OF IRRIGATION FACILITIES

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District (KID), Benton County, Washington, relating to the Cottonwood Meadows irrigation facilities; authorizing and directing actions.

Section 1. RECITALS AND FINDINGS.

1.2 The Cottonwood Meadows development encompasses 41 lots in west Kennewick. Aissata Sidibe (“Sidibe”) constructed, to KID standards, an irrigation system for the Cottonwood Meadows development, including a pond and pump station, with the express purpose of dedicating these irrigation facilities to KID.

1.3 The Cottonwood Meadows irrigation facilities, as described in Exhibits A and B of *Dedication of Irrigation Facilities*, have been inspected and approved by KID.

1.4 On December 21, 2021, Sidibe executed the *Dedication of Irrigation Facilities*, dedicating to KID all irrigation facilities for Cottonwood Meadows, as described in Exhibits A and B of *Dedication of Irrigation Facilities*.

Section 8. IMPLEMENTATION. The KID District Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such action as appropriate and necessary to administer and enforce this Resolution.

Section 9. REPEALER; FUTURE ACTIONS. Any KID act prior to and inconsistent with this Resolution is hereby superseded and repealed. Nothing in this Resolution shall limit the future authority of KID to modify, rates charges and assessments.
