KENNEWICK IRRIGATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION 2022-13

Authorization to Waive Competitive Bidding and Award a Contract to Purchase a used 2001 CAT 623G Motor Scraper from Cole Equipment; Pursuant to RCW 87.03.435(3)(c)

A **RESOLUTION** of the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District (KID), Benton County, Washington, relating to the purchase of certain materials, goods, and equipment, not associated with public works projects.

Section 1. RECITALS AND FINDINGS.

1.1 The Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District has established a General Purchasing Policy 2.13 that establishes the rules for acquiring services, contractors, materials, supplies, and equipment.

1.2 RCW 87.03.435(3)(c) provides for establishing the purchase price by direct negotiation if the purchase is clearly limited to a single source of supply or to purchases involving special facilities, services, or market conditions, in which instances the purchase price may be best established by negotiation.

Section 2. PURCHASE OF CAT 623G MOTOR SCRAPER

2.1 The District has a Capital Improvement Program that includes improvement projects that require this equipment.

2.2 Capital improvements will continue in the future, and this equipment will be necessary for these ongoing activities.

2.3 During the evaluation process for the purchase of a new motor scraper, it was brought to our attention that Cole Equipment has available a used 2001 CAT 623G Motor Scraper for \$215,000, plus applicable sales tax, fees, and shipping.

2.4 Through an analysis, the cost of ownership per hour of this used scraper is \$15.06, which is a significant cost savings compared to other comparable scraper options, which represents a market condition in which the purchase price is best established by direct negotiations.

2.5 This used CAT 623G Motor Scraper represents a unique situation that is of good value and is advantageous to KID.

Section 8. IMPLEMENTATION. The KID District Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such action as appropriate and necessary to administer and enforce this Resolution.

Section 9. REPEALER; FUTURE ACTIONS. Any KID act prior to and inconsistent with this Resolution is hereby superseded and repealed. Nothing in this Resolution shall limit the future authority of KID to modify, rates charges and assessments.
