KENNEWICK IRRIGATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION 2022-20

Authorization to Waive Competitive Bidding and Award a Contract to Purchase an Allen-Bradley VFD from Columbia Electric Supply; Pursuant to RCW 87.03.435(3)(c)

A **RESOLUTION** of the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District (KID), Benton County, Washington, relating to the purchase of certain materials, goods, and equipment, not associated with public works projects.

Section 1. RECITALS AND FINDINGS.

1.1 The Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District has established a General Purchasing Policy 2.13 that establishes the rules for acquiring services, contractors, materials, supplies, and equipment.

1.2 RCW 87.03.435(3)(c) provides for establishing the purchase price by direct negotiation if the purchase is clearly limited to a single source of supply or to purchases involving special facilities, services, or market conditions, in which instances the purchase price may be best established by negotiation.

Section 2. PURCHASE OF ALLEN-BRADLEY VFD

2.1 KID's Cherry Creek Regional Reservoir and Pump Station utilize Allen-Bradley equipment.

2.2 The first two pumps installed in the Cherry Creek system have Allen-Bradley VFDs.

2.3 Purchasing this Allen-Bradley VFD for the Cherry Creek third pump is necessary to enable uniformity in the pump and motor control.

2.4 KID Engineering Staff has determined by a thorough vendor search that Rockwell Automation is the sole distributor of Allen-Bradley equipment, and their sole distributor in this area is Columbia Electric Supply.

Section 8. IMPLEMENTATION. The KID District Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such action as appropriate and necessary to administer and enforce this Resolution.

Section 9. REPEALER; FUTURE ACTIONS. Any KID act prior to and inconsistent with this Resolution is hereby superseded and repealed. Nothing in this Resolution shall limit the future authority of KID to modify, rates charges and assessments.
