KENNEWICK IRRIGATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION 2022-28

Authorization to Waive Competitive Bidding and Award a Contract to Purchase Parts for a CAT 657G Scraper and a CAT 825 Compactor from Western States CAT; Pursuant to RCW 87.03.435(3)(c)

A **RESOLUTION** of the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District (KID), Benton County, Washington, relating to the purchase of certain materials, goods, and equipment, not associated with public works projects.

Section 1. RECITALS AND FINDINGS.

1.1 The Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District has established a General Purchasing Policy 2.13 that establishes the rules for acquiring services, contractors, materials, supplies, and equipment.

1.2 RCW 87.03.435(3)(c) provides for establishing the purchase price by direct negotiation if the purchase is clearly limited to a single source of supply or to purchases involving special facilities, services, or market conditions, in which instances the purchase price may be best established by negotiation.

Section 2. PURCHASE OF CAT PARTS

2.1 The District has a CAT 657G Scraper that is in need of repair.

2.2 The District has a CAT 825 Compactor that is in need of repair.

2.3 The parts needed for both pieces of equipment total \$2,358.19, including tax, plus applicable fees and shipping.

2.4 KID Staff has determined by a thorough vendor search that Western States CAT is the only authorized distributor of CAT parts in our area.

2.5 CAT equipment and parts are proprietary and these are the only parts that can be used on this equipment.

Section 3. IMPLEMENTATION. The KID District Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such action as appropriate and necessary to administer and enforce this Resolution.

Section 4. REPEALER; FUTURE ACTIONS. Any KID act prior to and inconsistent with this Resolution is hereby superseded and repealed. Nothing in this Resolution shall limit the future authority of KID to modify, rates charges and assessments.

RESOLUTION 2022-28 IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District, Benton County, Washington, at a regular open public meeting with a quorum present thereof this 17th day of May, 2022.
