KENNEWICK IRRIGATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION 2023-41

2023 Water Allotment Recalibration

A **RESOLUTION** of the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District (KID), Benton County, Washington, relating to certain rates, charges, and assessments; removing certain rates, charges and surcharges and directing assessment process related select infrastructure stranded parcels; authorizing and directing actions.

Section 1. RECITALS AND FINDINGS.

1.1 The legal property owners of parcels identified on Attachment “A” designated as irrigable and, therefore, assessable, located within the boundaries of the District, have been notified that their parcel be relieved of assessment obligation by permanently transferring the irrigation water allotment for said parcels to the District.

1.2 The District has confirmed that the permanent transfer of the water allotment for the parcels described on Attachment “A” will not cause the assessable acreage of the District to be below the District’s total minimum irrigated acreage of 19,171 acres under the District’s water contract.


1.3 The application requirement of District Policy 4.17, “Irrigable Land Recalibration Principles” have been satisfied and all monies and/or obligations to the District due and owing on the subject property have been paid to the District through the first half of 2023 with the remainder due on October 31st, 2023.


Section 2. WATER ALLOCATION REMOVAL The water allocation assigned to the parcels described on Attachment “A” should be removed effective January 1st, 2024.

Section 3. IMPLEMENTATION. The KID District Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such action as appropriate and necessary to administer and enforce this Resolution.


Section 4. REPEALER; FUTURE ACTIONS. Any KID act prior to and inconsistent with this Resolution is hereby superseded and repealed. Nothing in this Resolution shall limit the future authority of KID to modify, rates charges and assessments.
