**NOTICE OF MITIGATED DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Kennewick Irrigation District (KID) has issued a Mitigated Determination of Non-significance under State Environmental Policy Act Rules (Chapter 197-11 WAC).

**Action Description:** The Main Canal 11.3 Underdrain Decommissioning Project is planned to occur in the vicinity of the Main Canal milepost 11.3 and consists of decommissioning an existing underdrain. Work includes but is not limited to installation of controlled density fill (CDF) or other lean concrete within an existing underdrain, minor earthwork around the underdrain entrance to shape the existing depression as needed to retain water, and construction of earth berms to direct overflow to and from the retention area into the Main Canal. In addition, a concrete section of canal road is planned to be installed on the uphill canal road to protect the HDPE canal liner from erosion during a large storm event.

After reviewing a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the agency, KID has determined that the proposed action will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. This determination is based in part on mitigating terms and conditions prescribed in the Mitigated Determination of Non-significance.
