NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Kennewick Irrigation District (KID) has issued a Determination of Non-significance under State Environmental Policy Act Rules (Chapter 197-11 WAC).

Action Description: The Elliot Lake Dam Erosion Protection Project will consist of erosion control protection through the installation of approximately 100 feet of HDPE liner within the principal spillway north of the existing concrete spillway structure, riprap on slopes adjacent to the concrete spillway and hydroseed of the downhill dam embankment.

After reviewing a complete environmental checklist and other information on file with the agency, KID has determined that the proposed action will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.

Comment Period: KID will not act upon this determination for a period of at least fourteen (14) days.
