

DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ACTION: The West Richland Master Plan provides guidance for the replacement irrigation system as development occurs in the West Richland area. The guidance in the plan includes, but is not limited to, transmission and distribution pipe sizing, projected irrigation demands and pumping requirements.

PROPONENT: Kennewick Irrigation District (KID)

LOCATION: The West Richland Master Plan area is located in a portion of the City of Richland, the City of West Richland and Benton County, Washington. The master plan covers the area that is bounded by the Badger East Lateral, Interstate 182, and Keene Rd and is in Section 13 of Township 9 North, Range 27 East and Sections 17, 18, 20 and 21 of Township 9 North, Range 28 East, Willamette Meridian.

RESPONSIBLE SEPA OFFICIAL: Seth Defoe, Land and Water Resources Manager

THRESHOLD DETERMINATION:

KID, the lead agency for this proposal, has determined that the proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2) (c) and Chapter 197-11 WAC. This decision was made after review of a completed SEPA Environmental Checklist dated February 17, 2026, and other information on file with the lead agency.
