

DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ACTION: The Cherry Creek W 45th Ave East Expansion Pipeline project will consist of installation of approximately 1,460 feet of buried 12” C900 PVC irrigation pipe and 700 feet of buried 16” ductile iron PC 250 irrigation pipe within the City of Kennewick street right-of-way.

PROPONENT: Kennewick Irrigation District (KID)

LOCATION: This project is located in Kennewick, Washington in portions of the W 45th Ave and S Garfield St. rights-of-way. The 12” section of pipe shall begin west of the intersection of W 45th Ave and S Ione Street and terminate near the intersection of W 45th Ave and S Everett St. The 16” section of pipe shall begin at the intersection of W 45th Ave and S Garfield St and terminate approximately at the southernmost boundary line of 625 W 45th Avenue in Kennewick, Washington (Parcel #124891000007000). This project is in Sections 23 and 24 of Township 8 North, Range 29 East, Willamette Meridian.

RESPONSIBLE SEPA OFFICIAL: Seth Defoe, Land and Water Resources Manager

THRESHOLD DETERMINATION: KID, the lead agency for this proposal, has determined that the proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2) (c) and Chapter 197-11 WAC. This decision was made after review of a completed SEPA Environmental Checklist dated May 26, 2026, and other information on file with the lead agency. The responsible official finds this information reasonably sufficient to evaluate the environmental impact of this proposal. This information is available to the public on request.
