NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Kennewick Irrigation District (KID) has issued a Determination of Non-significance under State Environmental Policy Act Rules (Chapter 197-11 WAC).

Action Description: The Olympia and 19th Intertie project will consist of installing approximately 82 linear feet of buried 16-inch ductile iron irrigation pipeline near the intersection of West 19th Avenue and South Olympia Street in Kennewick, Washington. The proposed pipeline will connect to an existing City of Kennewick water pipeline being decommissioned to an existing Kennewick Irrigation District irrigation main pipeline, allowing the former City pipelines to be incorporated into KID's irrigation system. Construction will include pipeline installation, fittings, valves, connections to existing utilities, trench excavation and backfill, and restoration of disturbed surfaces within the public right-of-way and other affected areas, as applicable.

After reviewing a complete environmental checklist and other information on file with the agency, KID has determined that the proposed action will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.

Comment Period: KID will not act upon this determination for a period of at least fourteen (14) days.
